Rules for the Individual Events For Techminds -2010

Test Your Skills in 'C'

1. Institute can send any number of participants in the competition.
2. This event is a two category event:
Cat 1 for UG . Students from BCA,B.Sc.(IT/CS),PGDCA,.....
Cat 2 for PG. Students from B.E./B.Tech./MCA/M.Sc./M.Tech,.....
3. Duration of this event will be 90 minutes.
4. The test will comprise of 100 objective type questions .
5. For each incorrect answer one fourth (1/4) of the total marks allotted to the Question will be deducted.
6. No deduction from the total score will be made if no response is indicated for the question.
7. More than one answer/overwriting indicated against a question will be deemed as incorrect answer and will be negatively marked.

IT Quiz

1. Every institute/college can send only one team comprising of three Participants.
2. The preliminary round will comprise of a written test based on Information Technology. First four qualifying teams will be selected for final rounds.
3. The final contest shall comprise of an open stage competition.
4. Rules of each round will be announced before each round.

Paper presentation

1. Institute can send any number of participants in the competition.
2. In this event the participants will have to present their technical papers in the presence of the judges and audience. Audience and judges are free to Interact with the participants regarding the paper.
3. Six minutes for presentations and two minutes for questions /answers will be allotted to each participant.
4. Any extension of time will lead to deduction in the points by judges. For presentation a LCD/OHP facility will be provided.
5. Office 2003 and adobe acrobat reader 8 will be provided.

4. Time allotted will be 1 hour.

Application development

- 1.Only one team from a college consisting of two participants is allowed.
- 2.Time allotted will be 3 hours.
- 3.Problem will be given on the spot.
- 4.Context sensitive help is allowed during the development.
Software available on the systems: Visual basic/.net platform with back end MS-Access/Oracle and C/C++/Java.

Sell It

1. Every institute/college can send only one team consisting of maximum Three Participants.
2. Team will be provided a product or brand through a slip system.
3. The team will be given 15 minutes to think about the enactment of the Advertisement.
4. There is no language bar.
5. The team will perform the advertisement in 3 minutes followed by 2 Minutes for Questioning by the judges and participating teams.
6. Props are allowed.
7. The first bell will ring after 2 minutes during the enactment and the final bell will ring after one minute of the first bell.
8. Teams should ensure that language used should not be vulgar/offensive /improper.

Business quiz

- 1 .Every institute/college can send only one team comprising of three Participants.
2. The preliminary round shall comprise of a written test based on general Business Information. Only the first four qualifying teams will be chosen for final rounds.
3. The final contest shall comprise of an open stage competition.
4. Rules of each round will be announced before each round.

Essay Writing

1. Institute/college can send any number of participants in the competition.
2. Topic of essay will be provided on the spot. Topic may relate to Information Technology, Business world, Media, Education values etc.
3. Length of the essay should be between 300 to 500 words.
4. Duration of this event is one hour.
5. Language of the essay can be of English/Punjabi/Hindi.

General instructions For Techminds -2010
